

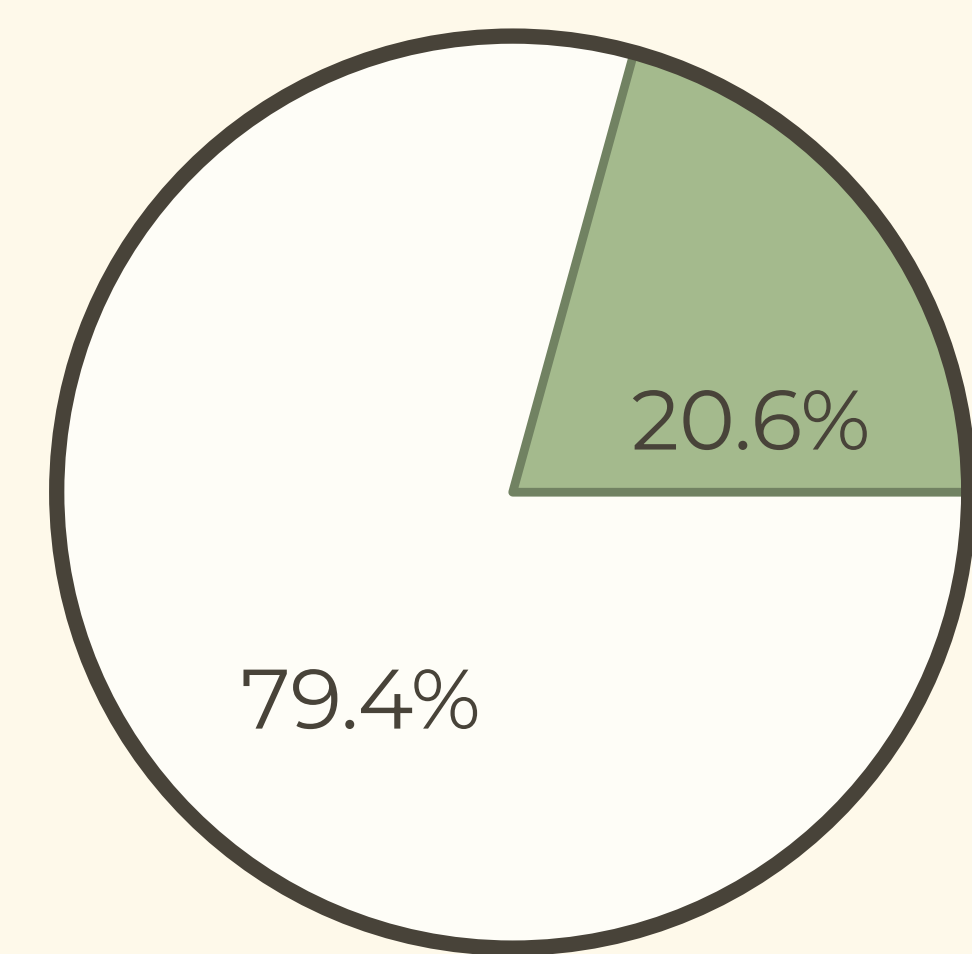

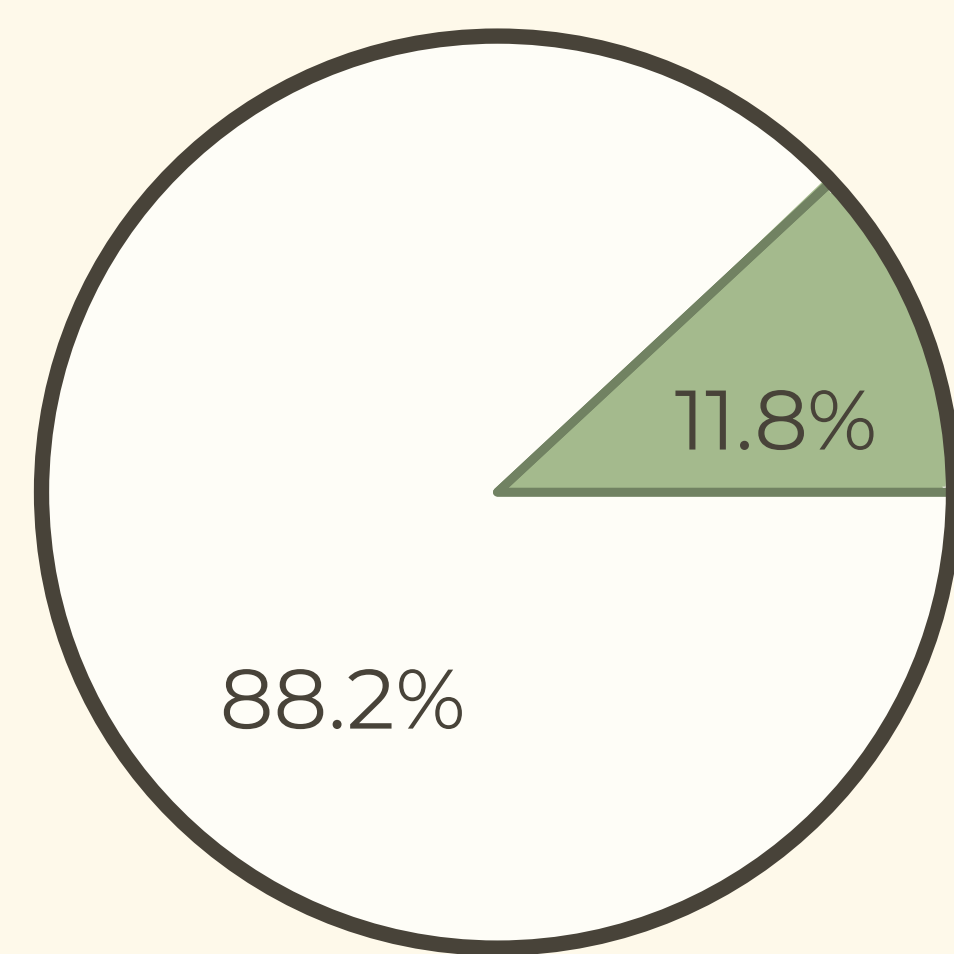
Introduction:

There are many design students who work with various materials that tend to go to waste afterwards. This can be very harmful to both the studio environment and the students in a financial way.

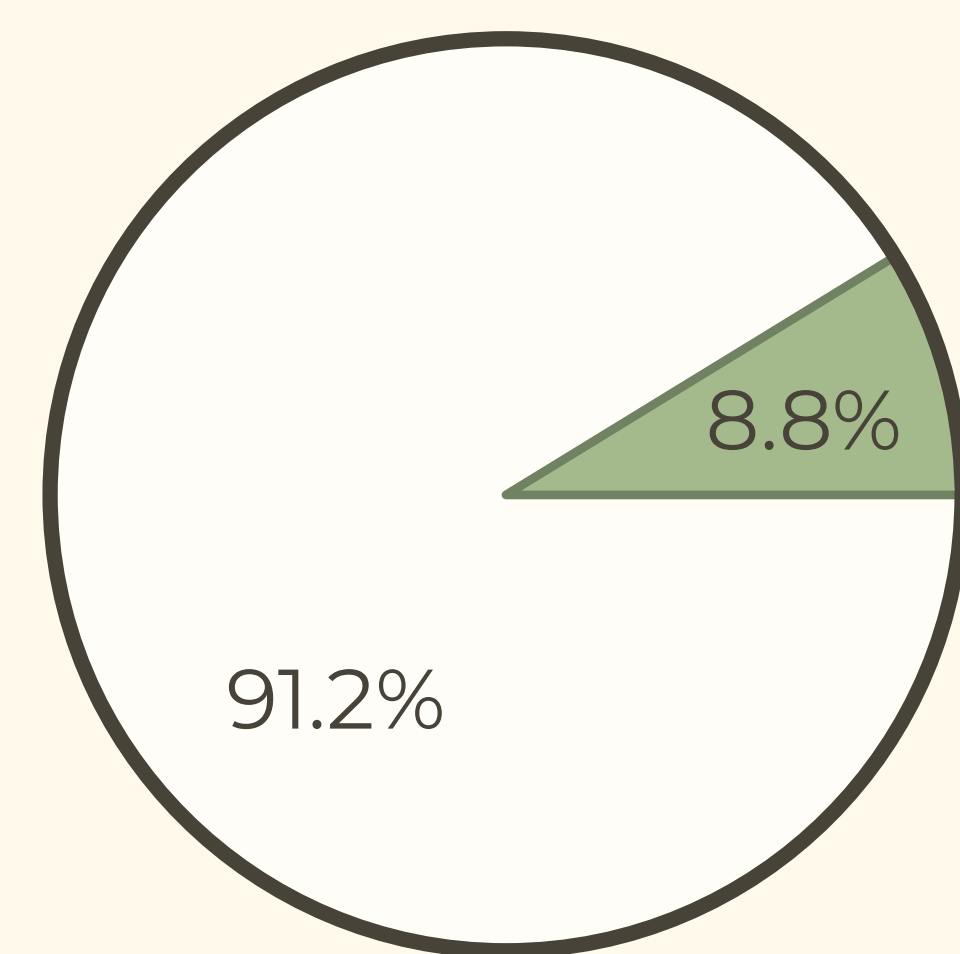

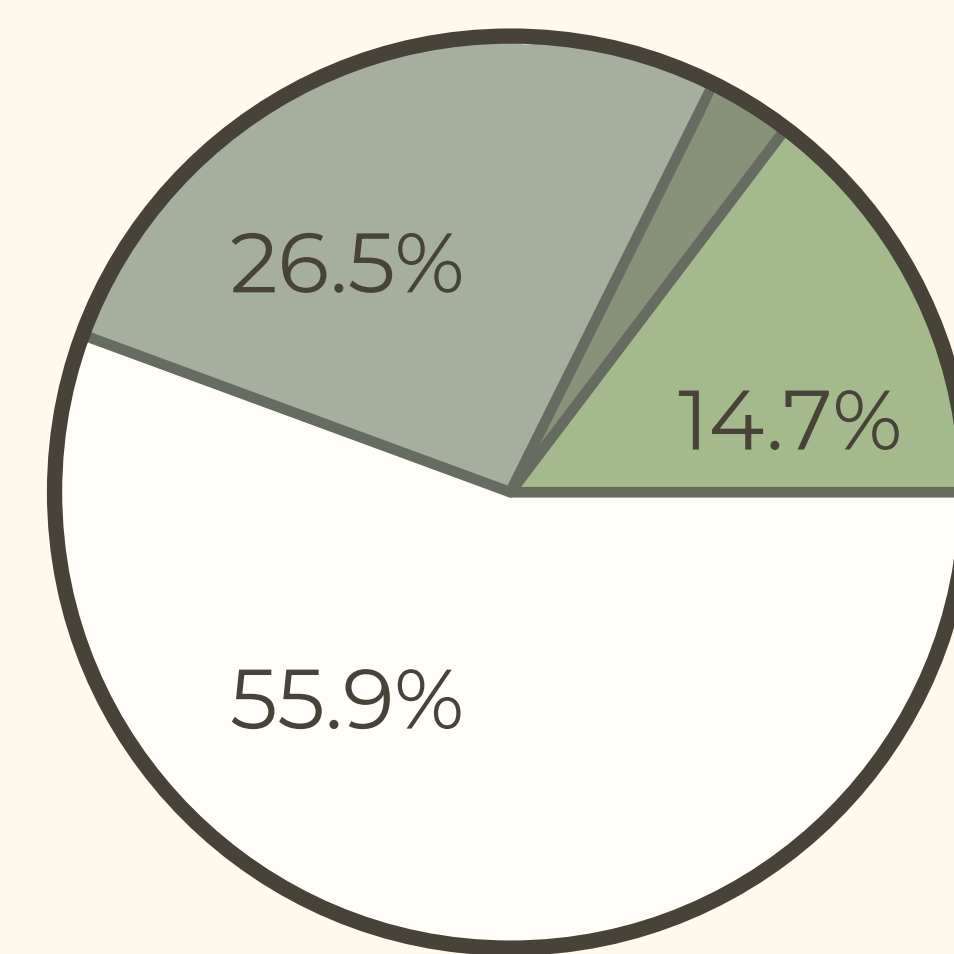

Results:

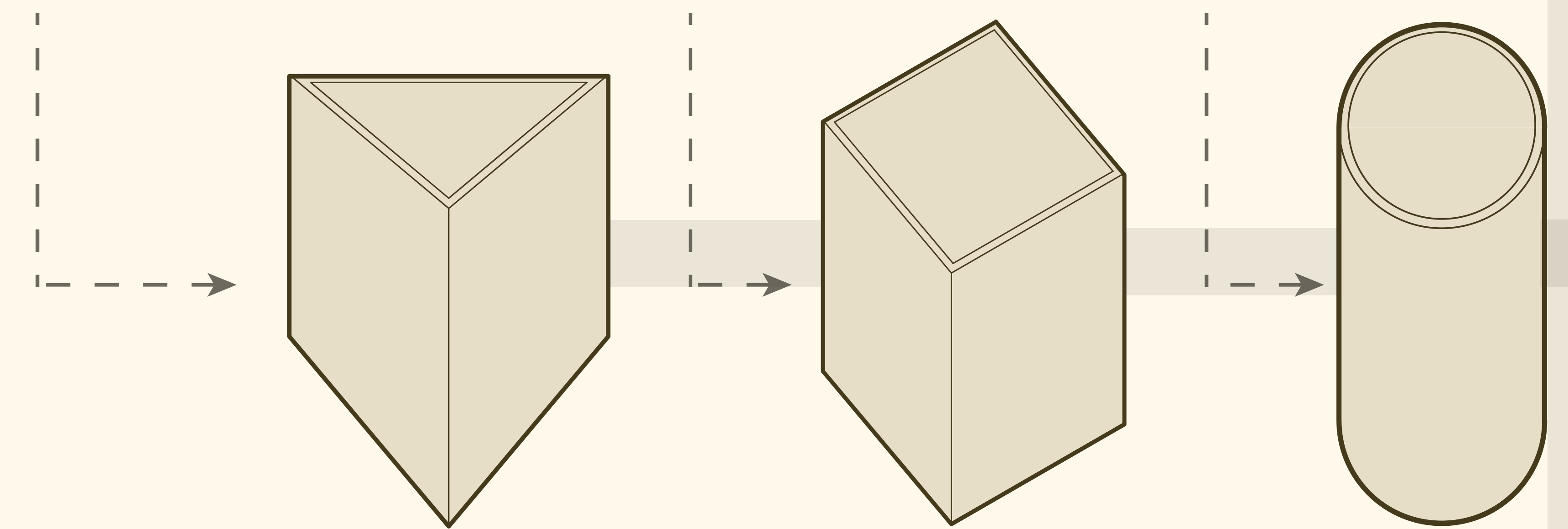
With our solution, students can now reuse the materials from the boxes in their projects instead of buying new ones. As a result, both the materials don't go to waste and students don't have to spend their money.

Steps of The Project:

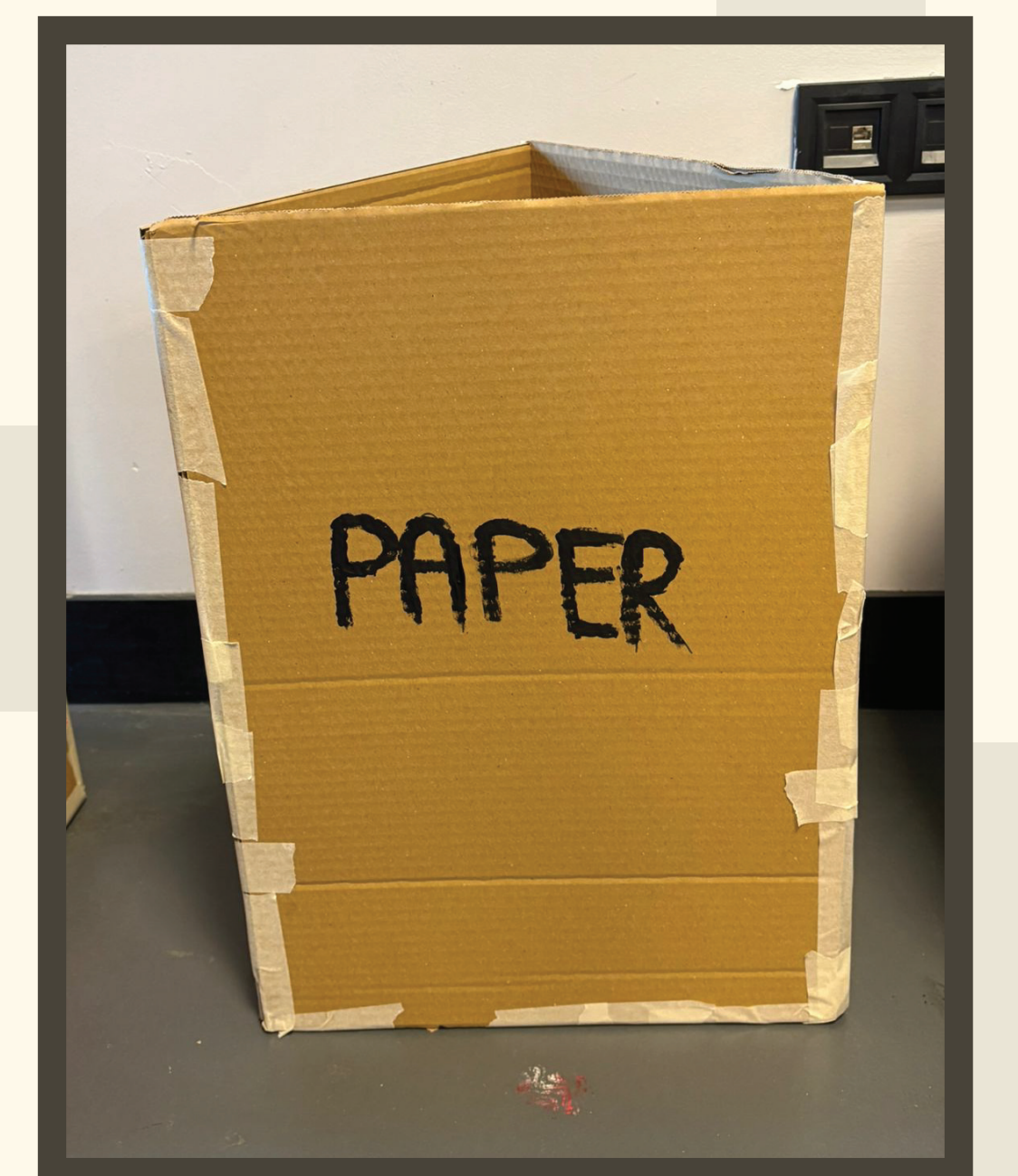
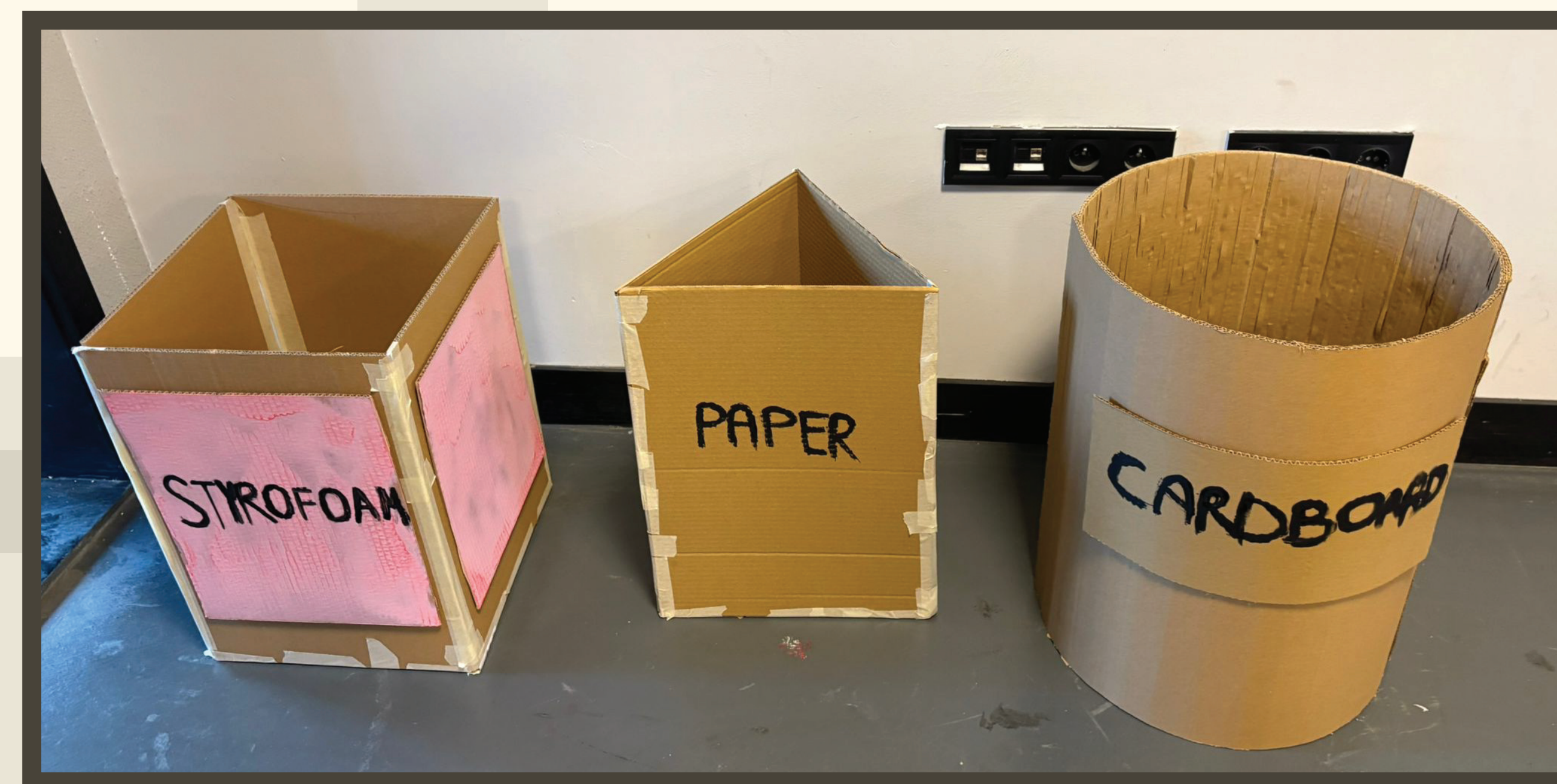
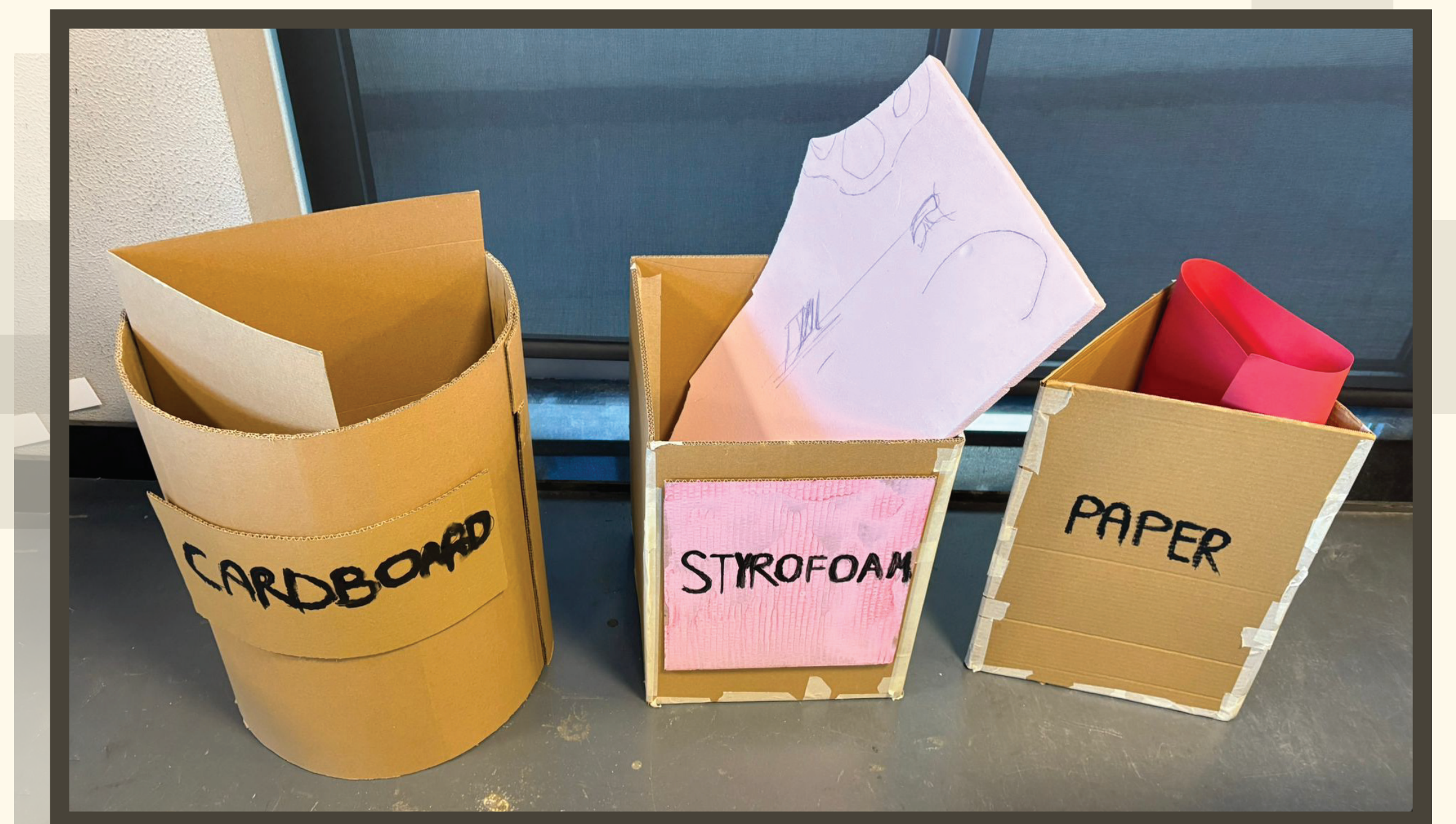
We decided to conduct a survey for architecture and design students to gather information on most used materials in their work and classes. After the data we received, we made boxes for each material to be used in studios.
