



What is done in TEDU 102: Service Learning?

- This course was designed to help students develop a critical perspective and ethical approach in working with people in different communities and community-based organizations through theories, practices, communityengaged projects, NGO collaborations, and field activities.
- Throughout the 14 weeks of dedicated efforts, students learned leadership and effective communication skills and raised their awareness regarding sustainable development.

Introducing TEDU102 with Numbers

- This course had 16 sections.
- 450 students were enrolled.

- 48 mentor students helped TEDU102 students during their project implementation.
